Current Version

The current shipping version is version 1.2. In addition, we have released version 1.2.1, which is a maintenance release. Future Versions

MyBowlingDiary 1.3

We are still targeting the release of MyBowlingDiary 1.3 for early November. Some of the enhancements will include:

- Editing / Deleting games directly from the database
- Improved frame handling
- Improved game screen with the ability to enter a starting lane
- Pull down menu to select the ball used in a particular frames
- Statistics on single pin attempts / conversions

Details on this release will be made available soon.

MyBowlingDiary 2.0

We are also working on MyBowlingDiary 2.0 (see our August 04 newsletter – available at <u>www.mybowlingdiary.com/newsletter.htm</u>). We did have our first internal release ready for testing, and are working on improvements. We are targeting April 2005 for our initial launch of this product.
